# GENERAL INFORMATION

The Kingdom of Cambodia is situated in Southeast Asia, bordered to the North by Thailand and Laos, to the East and the South by Vietnam and to the West by the Gulf of Thailand.

- Long Term Rice in rainy season

- Short Term Rice in dry season where the field is near by the irrigation canal system. Cambodia has also the farm-land along the both sides of the Mekong and Tonle Sap rivers where they plant corn, potatoes, cabbages, cucumber and any other different kind of vegetables. We plant as well the tree-fruit like banana, mango, jackfruit, sugar-cane, milk-apple, durian etc...

Besides all above, the Tonle Sap is the largest fishy-region in Asia. The Kingdom of Cambodia has rubber, teakwood, timber and all kind of best quality wood for furniture.

In the Northeast, the mountainous region with beautiful evergreens landscape where many different ethnic minority living in.

We have only two distinguished seasons: the rainy season from May to October, the dry season from November to April with 25 to 35 degrees C. Sometimes reaches 39 degrees C. The best time for a visit to Cambodia is from November to January with only 20 to 30 degree C.

## Practically speaking, Cambodia has four seasons:

- 1- November – February cool/dry
- 2- March – May hot/dry
- 3- June – August hot/wet
- 4- September – October cool/wet

The hottest days of the hot season rarely climb above 35 degrees C though the

sun can be quite tense. The cool season may push the mercury as low as 20 degrees C. The monsoons between June and October follow a regular pattern, clear morning with 1-3 hours rains in the afternoon. The cool dry season is more comfortable but the regularity of the wet season rains make them easy to plan around.

### **Visa & Entry Requirements**

Visa is available upon arrival at all international border check points and visa fee USD 25 for business and USD 20 for tourist. A visa is required for most nationalities. One month tourist visa is available on arrival at the airport in Phnom Penh and Siem Reap (Angkor Wat). Tourist visa USD 20/pax with 01 (4x6) Photo needed. Visa application form will be providing on inbound flights. The visa available at Thai-Cambodia or Vietnam-Cambodia overland border crossings. A passport valid for at least six months beyond the end of your visit. The Cambodia visa is issued officially at the following ports of entry.

#### ***A- With Thailand***

- Aranvapathet, Thailand/Poipet, Cambodia.  
Cambodian visa available. Thai transit visa available.
- Hat Let, Thailand/ Koh Kong Cambodia  
Cambodian visa available. Thai transit visa available.
- Chong Jom, Thailand/O'Smach, Cambodia. Situated in Oudar Meanchey Province, Opposite Thailand's Si Saket province. North-West of Seim Reap province. Cambodian visa available Thai transit.
- Ban Pakard, Thailand/Phsar Prom Pailin, Cambodia. Situated in Pailin Cambodia, opposite Thailand's Chanburi province. Cambodian visa available . Thai transit visa available.
- Ban Laem, Thailand/Daun Lem, Cambodia. Situated is Kamreng, Battombong province Cambodia, opposite Thailand's Chanburi province.

#### ***B- With Vietnam***

- Bavet checkpoint: Moc Bai, Vietnam/Bavet, Cambodia. Cambodian visa available at the border. Vietnam visa not available at the border.  
There are buses and vans leaving Phnom Penh every morning to HCMC and vice versa.
- Ving Xuong, Vietnam/Kaam Samnor, Cambodia  
Cambodian visa available at the border. Vietnam visa not available at the border.
- Phnom Den, Cambodia/Tinh Bien, Vietnam

At the time of printing this booklet, the availability of Cambodian visa at the border in UNKNOWN. Vietnamese visa not available of the border Phnom Den is located in Takeo Province. Take the taxi from Phnom Penh (Phsar Domkor) to Takeo Province, the continue to Phnom Den. Walk cross the border to Binh Bien Vietnam. From Tinh Bien take a motorcycle or taxi to Chau Doc is about 10km. Then continue by taxi to HCMC.

### **C- With Laos**

Voeung Kam, Laos/Dom Kralor, Cambodia

Cambodian visa available at the border. Lao visa not available at the border. From Phnom Penh, take taxi or bus to Stung Treng (via Kompong Cham or Kratie). From Stung Treng you can take the ferry boat or the minibus to the border.
