- Accommodation at Borei Bokor Hotel
- Dinner at local restaurant

Day 7 Kampot

- Full day sightseeing in Kampot to visit
- Phnom Bokor Mountain (former the French resort and old colonial building)
- Local Market (Fruit and Fresh sea food market)
- Visit Kep and relax at the beach
- Return to hotel in Kampot
- Sunset cruise on Kompot Lake
- Dinner at local restaurant

Day 8 Kampot/ Sihanouk Ville

- Breakfast at Hotel
- Afternoon, depart Kampot for Sihanouk, The drive will take 2 hours to Sihanouk Ville. En- route to Sihanok Ville is available to visit some Fishing village and take photo

- If time permit, visit Water Fall, local Market, Sunset View on the mountain

11 DAYS PHNOM PENH - KAMPOT - KEP-KOMPONG SOM (SIHANOUKVILLE) - PHNOM PENH - SIEM REAP

Day 1

- Phnom Penh - Arrival (B/L/D)
- Transfer from Phnom Penh International Airport to the hotel (rooms may not be ready until the afternoon).
- Lunch at hotel.
- Phnom Penh city tour: Visit the Victory Monument, and the National Museum, also called Musee des Beaux-Arts. A French archaeologist and painter, Georges Groslier, designed it in Khmer style in 1917. The museum contains a collection of Khmer art-notably sculptures – from throughout the ages. Visit the Royal Palace, built by King Norodom in 1866 on the site of the old town, and the Silver Pagoda. Located within the grounds of the Royal Palace, the Silver Pagoda is so named because of its floor, which is made up of 5000 silver tiles. The treasures found inside include a solid gold Buddha encrusted and weighing 90kilograms and a small 17th century emerald and baccarat crystal Buddha. End your afternoon with the visit of the Wat Phnom Temple, Phnom Penh's namesake. Dinner at local restaurant and accommodation at hotel.
- Phnom Penh - Tonle Bati - Takeo - Phnom Da - Kampot (B/L/D)

DAY 2 Phnom Penh/ Kapot

- Depart from Phnom Penh for Kampot.
- En route, stop at Tonle Bati and visit Ta Prohm temple (12-13th century) and Yeay Peau temple (12th century). Visit the Prasat Neang Khmao, the temple of the Black Virgin (10th century). Visit a silk weaving village before proceeding to Takeo.
- Lunch at local restaurant.
- Take a boat from Takeo to Phnom Da (please note that the speedboat does not have a cover or any shade-hat and sun tan cream essential). Visit Phnom Da temple, a pre-Angkorian laterite tower (6th century) and Asram Maharoseil (6th century), an Indian-style sandstone temple constructed in a style unlike any other

temple in Cambodia (the climb up is easy as this particular Phnom (hill) is not very high. The path up to the temple is steep, over some big rocks). Return to Takeo by boat and continue to Kampot, panoramic tour of the town and check-in at hotel.

- Dinner at local restaurant and accommodation at hotel in Kampot.

DAY 3 Kampot / Sihanouk Ville

- Drive to Kep, This beautiful coastal area was once the favorite holiday spot for Cambodia's French-influenced elite. Boat trip to Rabbit Island.
- Return to Kampot for lunch at local restaurant.
- Panoramic tour of Kampot town. Drive along the coasts and the
- Damrei (Elephant) Mountains to Kompong Som (Sihanoukville) (96 km. 2 hours drive).
- Check-in at hotel near by the beach
- Dinner at local restaurant

DAY 4 Sihanouk Ville

- Boat cruise for Koh Resey Island
- Lunch at Koh Resey
- Afternoon return to hotel
- Accommodation at local restaurant
- Sihanouk Ville (B/L/D)

DAY 5 Sihanouk Ville / Phnom Penh

- Free at leisure to enjoy the beach.
- Lunch free.
- Return to Phnom Penh in the afternoon with private car and guide.
- Dinner and accommodation at hotel.

DAY 6 Phnom Penh / Siem Reap

- Transfer to Phnom Penh International Airport and departure by SiemReap Airways International or similar to Siem Reap. Arrive at SiemReap International Airport, Arrived Siem Reap, welcome by yourlocal guide and direct transfer to Siem Reap town Visit the Roluos Group. The monuments of Roluos, which served as the capital of Indravarman I (reigned 877-890), The Rolous ruins are

among the oldest Khmer monuments in the Angkor area, dating to 9th century reign of Indravarman I. Two key temple sites remain, Bakong and Preah Ko. The latter consists of six bricks towers or prasats, arranged in two rows; the site is bounded by walls, with sandstone lintel decoration. Bakong is a five-step brick pyramid with a sandstone door ways. At the corners of the first three levels stand elephants hewn from single blocks of stone. Next to the ruin is an active Buddhist monastery. From here, you can continue south to the village of Rolous, which lent its name to the ruins.

- Lunch at hotel.
- In the afternoon, you will continue your temple visit, including Prasat Kravan with unique brick sculptures, Srah Srang, (“The Pool of Ablutions”) undoubtedly used in the past for ritual bathing, Banteay Kdei, surrounded by four concentric walls, Eastern Mebon, guarded at its corner by stone figures of harnessed elephants, some of which are still in a reasonable state of preservation, and Pre Rup, the mountain-temple until sunset. Dinner at local restaurant and accommodation at hotel.
- Siem Reap (B/L/D)

DAY 7 Siem Reap

- In the morning, drive to the typical Khmer countryside and visit Banteay Srei temple (10th c), regarded as the jewel in the crown of Classical Khmer Art. Continue to visit Banteay Samre, one of the most complete complexes at Angkor due to restoration using the method of “anastylosis”. The name Samre refers to an ethnic group of mountain people, who inhabited the region at the base of Phnom Kulen and were probably related to the Khmers. No inscriptions have been found for this temple, but the style of most of the architecture is of the classic art of the middle period similar to Angkor Wat. The proportions of Banteay Samre are splendid. A unique feature is an interior moat with laterite paving, which when filled with water must have given an ethereal atmosphere to the temple.
- Lunch at hotel.
- In the afternoon, you will continue your temple visits to Preah Khan. Built by the King Jayavarman VII, Preah Khan is, like Ta Prohm, a place of towered enclosures and shoulder hugging

corridors. Unlike Ta Prohm, however, the temple of Prea Khan is in a reasonable state of preservation and ongoing restoration efforts should maintain and even improve this situation. Continue to Neak Pean, a fountain built in the middle of a pool (representing the paradisiacal Himalayan mountain-lake), and Ta Som. Dinner at local restaurant and accommodation at hotel.

DAY 8 Siem Reap

- Morning, visit the most famous of all the temples on the plain of Angkor: Angkor Wat. The temple complex covers 81 hectares and is comparable in size to the Imperial Palace in Beijing. Its distinctive five towers are emblazoned on the Cambodian flag and the 12th century masterpiece is considered by art historians to be the prime example of classical Khmer art and architecture. Angkor Wat's five towers symbolize Meru's five peaks - the enclosing wall represents the mountains at the edge of the world and the surrounding moat, the ocean beyond.
- Lunch at hotel.
- Visit the South Gate (with its huge statues depicting the churning of the ocean of milk), the ancient capital of Angkor Thom (12th century), Bayon Temple (unique for its 54 towers decorated with over 200 smiling faces of Avolokitesvara), the Royal Enclosure, Phimeanakas, the Elephants Terrace and the Terrace of the Leper King. Sunset at Angkor Wat. Dinner at local restaurant and accommodation at hotel.
- Siem Reap (B/L/D)

DAY 9 Siem Reap

- Morning, drive to the remote Beng Mealea temple through the typical Khmer countryside (60Kms from Siem Reap). There is a lot to see in the approximately 2 hours drive as it takes you through many lively villages and along kilometers of rice paddies. Explore the long abandoned temple (11th C), strangled by the jungle.
- Lunch box will be provided at the site.

- A further 1 hr drive brings you to Koh Ker, situated in the northeast of Siem Reap. Discover the long abandoned temples in the forests of northern Cambodia. Also known as Chok Gargyar, it served as the capital of Jayavarman IV (reigned 928-42). His son and successor Harshavarman I moved the capital back to Angkor in 944. There are a remarkable number of religious buildings in the Koh Ker region, considering the short space of time that it was the capital of the empire. There are more than 30 major structures and experts believe there may have been as many as 100 minor sacred buildings in the region. It was also a prolific period for gigantic sculpture and several of the most impressive pieces in the National Museum in Phnom Penh come from Koh Ker, including a huge garuda (half-man, half-bird creature). Return to Siem Reap. Dinner at local restaurant and accommodation at hotel.
- Siem Reap (B/L/D)

DAY 10 Siem Reap

- Morning, visit the floating village of Chong Khneas, located 10 kilometers south of Siem Reap. Visit the village and take an excursion in a traditional wooden boat on the Tonle Sap Lake, the “Great Lake” of Cambodia, one of the wonders of Asia.
- Note: From Feb-July, the visit to the Tonle Sap Lake is not recommended because of the low water level. The below visits will be provided instead in the morning: Visit “Les Artisans d’Angkor-Chantiers Ecoles” of Siem Reap and spend time at leisure at a local Market. Lunch at hotel
- Afternoon, sightseeing to visit: Takeo, Thommanon, Chau Say Tevoda and Ta Prohm, one of the most beautiful temples in the area, as it has been relatively untouched since it was discovered and retains much of its mystery. Its appeal lies in the fact that, unlike the other monuments of Angkor, it was abandoned and swallowed by the jungle, looking very much the ways most of the Angkor temples appeared when European explorers first stumbled upon them.
- Dinner and accommodation at hotel.

DAY 11 Siem Reap

- In morning Visit the Silk Farm center. Learn the different stages of the complex process of producing handmade silk. On the way back hotel, visit the nearby Western Baray and the temple of Western Mebon.
- Lunch at hotel.
- Afternoon transfer to Siem Reap international airport for flight

NORTH CAMBODIA ADVENTURE

Day 01 Arrive Cambodia border Poi Pet around 09 – 10AM (Poi Pet / Banteay Meanchey / Banteay Chma temples)

- After immigration clearance meet Phnom Penh Tours representative and transfer to Batambang (2 hours drive from Thai border)
- Lunch at Local restaurant in Banteay Meanchey town
- After lunch continue drive to visit Banteay Cham temples

The civil War between the Khmer and Chmapa Kingdom in the 12th century, king Jayavarman VII built a temple in the Cambodian jungle To honor five heroes who died in defense of their country, one of them being his son. A “fine



Citadel”of eight temples, situated on a nine – square kilometer site and surrounded by a moat, Is distinguished by expertly rendered base-reliefes depicting war between the kingdoms and the accession of the Khmer king to the throne. Because of its location, Banteay Chmar survived the destructive Khmer Rouge period of the 1970s. A remote and ruined temple with massive face- towers and intricate

carvings shrouded in mist and jungle vegetation, Banteay Chmar conjures up all the romanticism of a lost Khmer capital

- Late afternoon leave Banteay Chmar for Battambang city Arrive Batdambang city at early evening
- Accommodation at TEO hotel
- Dinner at hotel or local restaurant
- Battambang is the second largest city in Cambodia located on a rich and fertile plain which provide much of the rice and other important plants for Cambodia . The beautiful River (Sangke River) cuts through the the center of town. There are many colonial building, shops, houses still remain in the city. The region hase numerous pre Angkorian and post Angkor ian sites. The most interesting temples are Wat Ek (11 century – Suryavarman 1) and Phnom Banan temple.



Day 2 Battambang city

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Morning depart hotel to visit Provincial Museum and continue to visit Banon Temple ,five sandstone Towers on the top of the hill and enjoy the magnificent view.
- Return to the town to visit local market
- Lunch at local restaurant
- Back to hotel
- Late afternoon leave hotel for Ek Phnom temple (11th century– Suryavarman I
- Visit fish market, the famous Cambodian fish paste, is made. (optional boat cruise on Sangke river)
- Dinner at local restaurant



Day 03 Battambang – Siem Reap

- Breakfast at hotel
- Morning leave Battambang for Siem Reap (3 hours drive by car)
(Optional : take a speed boat from Battambang to Siem Reap 5 hours, along the way to Siem Reap is available to visit fishing village on Tonle Sap and seeing the birds century)



Note : The boat excursion is available only from August to December

- Arrival Siem Reap transfer to hotel

Day 03 Siem Reap

Afternoon sightseeing to visit:

- South gate of Angkor Thom
- Bayon
- Elephant and Leper King terrace
- Angkor Wat until sunset
- Dinner at the hotel
